INTRODUCTION TO SKILLS FOR GROWTH -SME SUPPORT

Skills for Growth - SME Support is a fully funded, tailored service to help up-skill employees and improve productivity. Delivered by GC Business Growth Hub in partnership with the Greater Manchester Chamber of Commerce (GMCC), the service is commissioned by the Greater Manchester Combined Authority (GMCA) and funded through the European Social Fund (ESF), to help SMEs grow through re-shaping, developing talent and enhancing team performance.

Offering impartial advice and guidance over a 26-week programme, our team was developed to help Greater Manchester come back stronger from the challenges presented during the pandemic, this time better equipped and better prepared with the skills for the future. Each participating business is assigned a dedicated Skills Coach who will work with them to develop and action a bespoke productivity plan throughout their 26-week period on the programme.

Specialist areas

We offer 2 specialist services within our wider programme to help SMEs build back better. Our specialists include:



APPRENTICESHIPS

Identify relevant apprenticeships for employees, match with appropriate training providers and assist with levy-matchmaking applications where applicable

Referrals to specialists will be made where suitable by our Skills Coaches for SME programme participants.

SMEs taking part in the programme will have access to a dedicated Skills Coach, up to 26 weeks of support, with an experience tailored to their individual needs at no cost to their business. Benefits include:

- Assisted access to Kickstart Scheme, Apprenticeship opportunities and learning initiatives associated with the National Skills Fund
- Explore all grants and funding available from fully and part funded courses, to government grants and incentives

- Specialist consultation and support in health and wellbeing, and apprenticeships
- Guidance with employment, redeployment and redundancy
- Ensure best practice for remote and agile operating procedures, health and safety, and HR practices
- Connection to Greater Manchester Good Employment Charter, Bridge GM, GMCVO, among others dedicated to the development of the region's future industry plan


